### **About the Course:**

This 8-hour block of training will provide officers with a comprehensive overview of DUI enforcement. A summary of all impaired driving curriculums, developed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), will be provided. This summary will enable officers to determine if they require or desire future DUI training. Pharmacology and physiology will be discussed to enhance the officer's knowledge about the effects of alcohol/drugs on the human body. Eye examinations will focus on the dynamics of papillary reaction to stimuli. The dynamics will be related to possible impairment caused by alcohol and/or drugs. This course will not train officers in field testing but a review will be conducted of common mistakes made by officers when conducting such tests. This review will enable officers to avoid future defense challenges. This course will emphasize the eight implied consent warnings and the statutory elements required for enforcement. The final portion of the training will focus on the chemical testing of breath, blood and urine. Relevant court cases will be highlighted throughout the training.
