ILLINOIS LAW ENFORCEMENT REFORM ACT OF 2021 - ANALYSIS

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Illinois Law Enforcement Reform Act of 2021 has been enacted into law. Spanning over seven hundred pages, the Act creates the Stateside Use of Force Standardization Act; the No Representation Without Population Act; and the Reporting of Deaths in Custody Act; and the Task Force on Constitutional Rights and Remedies Act; It modifies the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act; the Criminal Code of 2012; the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963; the Unified Code of Corrections; the Open Meetings Act; the Freedom of Information Act, the State Employee Indemnification Act; the State Police Act; and the Illinois Police Training Act. The Act also has four separate effective dates spanning the next four years. This presentation will define and analyze the practical effect of the provisions that go into effect on July 1, 2021. It will also cover the amendments contained in House Bill 3443 (the trailer bill) that just passed both houses. The changes involving the Use of Force, the creation of the statutory Duty to Render Aid, and the statutory Duty to Intervene will be identified, analyzed, and discussed. The Law Enforcement Misconduct provisions will be identified and discussed. Finally, the provisions of this Legislation that go into effect on January 1, 2022, will be identified and discussed. The ultimate goal of this presentation is to offer guidance to Illinois Law Enforcement agencies in dealing with this Police Reform Act of 2021.
