The course content will include but not limited to basic operations of CEWs, nomenclature of CEWs in use, proper handling and maintenance, legal updates, and case law.

Students will participate in a lecture/discussion supplemented with a presentation provided by Axon International. Students will also participate in practical exercises to include proper loading and unloading drills, proper drive stun applications, deployment risk, drawing drills, and proper evidence packaging procedures.
