As a mentor and teacher to many police departments and law enforcement officers across the country, he is committed to helping them all "come home." Law Enforcement is facing a host of pressures: morale, budgeting, staffing, a hostile media environment, and a myriad of other issues. In many ways, their struggle to "come home" can be as challenging as that of a military veteran. This class will increase the resiliency of your officers while equipping them to train and respond to their fellow officers.
