### **PURPOSE OF COURSE:**

This one day, 8-hour program has been designed to assist newly-assigned juvenile officers in developing skills needed to effectively interrogate youths. It will also refresh detention and interrogation skills for experienced officers.

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Students will examine and discuss the latest changes to the Juvenile Court Act, Chapter 704, Articles 1 and V, Delinquency Provisions, along with recent court cases directing law enforcement in conducting proper interrogations and interviews while guaranteeing minors' rights.

## **COURSE GOALS:**

The training goals of this program include comprehensive examinations of the following topical areas:

- Optimal law enforcement interrogations skills
- Juvenile Court Act, Chapter 708, Delinquency Provisions, Article V
- Juvenile rights
- Chapter 704 and Illinois Detention Law, PA 85-1443
- Recent revisions to the Juvenile Court Act, Chapter 705
- Responsibilities of arresting police officers and juvenile officers
- Recent court decisions affecting implementation of the Juvenile Court Act
- Chronic truants
- Station Adjustments
- Parental rights and responsibilities
