COURSE DESCRIPTION

This 4-hour training focuses on understanding the PREA Information Presentation from IN.gov discusses the medical and mental health care that victims of sexual abuse are entitled to under the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA). This understanding focuses on mental practitioners, medical practitioners and other employees or contractors that have unsupervised contact with incarcerated inmates.

GOALS:

The goals of this course are as follows:

- 1. To understand the PREA standards applicable to medical and mental
- 2. To understand the role of the mental health etc. when interacting with inmates
- 3. To understand their responsibilities under PREA standards.

COURSE PREREQUISITES:

Only personnel who are currently employed by a County Jail or any person who is referred by the County Sheriff or the Jail Administrator may attend.
