On March 17, 2017, I wrote my suicide note. In the depths of despair, I was ready to surrender to the shadows. Yet, a timely call from a friend, became the catalyst for a profound transformation, I am now the proud first member of the 10% Club, a community that emerged form the crucible of adversity. This is not just a story of survival but a celebration of resilience, empathy, and the daily commitment to make a positive impact in someone's life every day. This presentation will change how you view suicide, mental health and most importantly how you address trauma.
