# SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS (DRONES) IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This course is focused on unmanned aircraft systems (UAS), for law enforcement. The course is designed to equip officers with the knowledge, skills, and legal understanding needed to operate drones effectively and responsibly within their roles. Ultimately, this course is meant to enable law enforcement to harness UAS technology in ways that support public safety, enhance operational effectiveness, and protect civil liberties.

#### **GOALS:** The Goals of the Course are as follows:

- Operational Training: Teach officers the technical skills required for safe and effective drone operations, including flight controls, navigation, emergency response, and maintenance. This training also covers best practices for managing drones in various environmental and situational conditions.
- Legal and Ethical Considerations: Educate officers on federal, state, and local laws, including the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations and privacy laws, which are essential to prevent misuse and maintain public trust. This includes understanding policies around data collection, retention, and respecting citizens' privacy rights.
- Tactical and Mission-Specific Applications: Explore how drones can assist with specific law enforcement
  missions, such as surveillance, search and rescue, accident scene reconstruction, crowd monitoring, and disaster
  response. Drones can provide real-time intelligence in dangerous or hard-to-reach areas, improving safety and
  efficiency.
- Ethics and Community Relations: Provide guidance on the ethical implications of drone usage and how to communicate these practices to the public to foster transparency and trust. This aspect emphasizes responsible use, limits on data usage, and procedures for community engagement and accountability.
- Risk Management and Safety Protocols: Develop officers' understanding of risk assessment, safety protocols, and incident response, both to avoid accidents and to manage any unplanned events or malfunctions in populated or sensitive areas.
