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### **PURPOSE OF COURSE:**

To provide officers with the opportunity to practice and perform the necessary skills to prevail in real world active shooter responses in a safe and constructive training environment.

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This 8-hour course is designed to teach officers the critical skills needed to effectively respond to an active shooter incident, prioritizing threat engagement and the prevention of loss of life. This will be accomplished by a very intense and strenuous training schedule to develop the skills and tactics needed in a short amount of time.

### **COURSE GOALS:**

- To provide a detailed explanation of conventional police tactics for managing barricade/hostage situations.
- To review a study of the dramatic increase in the number of workplace and school shooting incidents.
- To provide students with an understanding of why Rapid Deployment/Immediate Action techniques were developed and the need for them to be integrated into the tactics available to law enforcement.
- To assist participants in developing an awareness of the critical elements that constitute an active shooter and when the use of Rapid Deployment/Immediate Action tactics are appropriate and necessary.
- To provide student with an understanding of what should be accomplished by the initial responding officers and what the components and responsibilities of the “contact” and/or “rescue” team are.
- To identify and discuss use of force and safety priority issues related to Rapid Deployment/Immediate Actions incidents, including immediate defense of life, law, policy and procedure, and established safety priorities.

**STUDENTS MUST BRING:**

1. Laptop
2. Notepad/pen
3. Medical training gear
4. Targets
5. Simuntion/UTM gear (firearms, conversions, ammunition, eye protection)
6. Role Players
7. Rifle with minimum of 3 magazines and sling.
8. Pistol with minimum of 3 magazines
9. Duty/issued equipment (i.e., plate carrier, duty belt, radio)

**Non-Member Tuition:**

**\$0.00.** Non-member tuition shall apply to State/Federal agencies and Local Law Enforcement agencies which are not members of MTU #9. Tuition will be invoiced to departments upon course completion.
