COURSE DESCRIPTION

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The Officer will be able to set up and employ the TI Training Simulator. The Officer will be able to instruct simulated scenarios and conduct individual and group debriefs. The Officer will be able to instruct use of force decision making by utilizing established case law, Illinois Peace Officer's Use of Force statute, and the Illinois SAFE-T Act.
